Brief Itinerary

Two nights acclimatizing in a local, beachside, surf lodge.

Three weeks of Primary School teaching on an outer island in the Northern Province of Fiji.

You'll be involved in teaching a range of Fijian primary school curricular subjects including English, Maths, Geography, Science and Physical Education.

Five nights week relaxing at a local beachside surf lodge.

Everything from when you arrive in Fiji until the end.

Incl. meals, accommodation, island day trips as below, briefing and support, all domestic travel and airport transfers.

Accommodation is a mixture of dorms, camping and authentic Fijian homestays.

During your five days downtime at the end you will be riverside camping, shark snorkelling, sea kayaking, jungle hiking, yoga (on availability) and doing a weaving workshop.

During weekends you will visit two waterfall, do a two tank dive on the Rainbow Reef, the Soft Coral capital of the world and go to a natural waterslide.
